  - a. Candidates who are rising activists and leaders, advocating around issues that affect Hispanic youth and their families
  - b. Youth Candidates who are interested in taking-on a greater leadership role in the Hispanic community
  - c. Candidates who are willing to utilize the conference experience for the benefit of the community in a tangible manner, after they return from the conference
  - d. Candidates who will take the initiative to conduct fund-raising on their own, to raise additional money to help supplement their partial scholarship
